Appointment of a Northern Virginia Faculty Representative to the Commission on
Graduate Studies and Policies

WHEREAS, there are approximately 1400 graduate students and approximately 85 resident tenure-track faculty members in northern Virginia that are enrolled in and assigned to the Washington-Alexandria Center, the Northern Virginia Center, the Alexandria Research Institute, the Marion duPont Scott Equine Medical Center, and the Metropolitan Institute; and

WHEREAS the needs of graduate students and tenure-track faculty based in the northern Virginia area are different from those of the graduate students and faculty located at the Blacksburg campus and other extended campus sites; and

WHEREAS there are some degree programs and teaching delivery modes at the northern Virginia campuses that are distinctive from those represented at the Blacksburg campus or other extended campus sites;

THEREFORE be it resolved, that a tenure-track faculty member from a northern Virginia campus be appointed to the Commission on Graduate Studies and Policies to represent the faculty and graduate student constituency of the Washington-Alexandria Center, the Northern Virginia Center, the Alexandria Research Institute, the Marion duPont Scott Equine Medical Center, and the Metropolitan Institute.
