Resolution for Change in Membership of Commission on Outreach and International Affairs
(Revision of University Council Bylaws)

Whereas, a resolution was passed by University Council on May 5, 2003, changing the name of the former Commission on Outreach to the Commission on Outreach and International Affairs; and,

Whereas, the Commission for Outreach and International Affairs originates resolutions on outreach and international affairs to effect or change university policy, and passes along these policy resolutions to University Council, which consists of a broad representation of administration, faculty, staff, and students, and serves as an advisory body to the president of the university; and

Whereas, recent restructuring of Outreach and International Affairs included changes for titles of positions that served as ex officio members of the Commission on Outreach and International Affairs; and,

Whereas, the University Council on International Programs represents the area of International Programs in the restructured Outreach and International Affairs,

Therefore Let It Be Resolved that the membership of the Commission on Outreach and International Affairs be changed from the current wording to the proposed wording as shown below:

Current wording “**One representative from area of International Programs appointed by President (three-year term).**”

Proposed wording: “**One member from the area of International Affairs who shall be the chair of the University Council on International Affairs (UCIA) or his/her designee.**”
